Former Chief Minister of U.P. and Prime Minister of India; born at Noorpur village, Ghaziabad, U.P.; educated at Meerut and Agra; member of AICC, 1929-67; Vice-Chairman, District Board, 1930-35; Member, U.P. Legislative Assembly, 1937-39 and 1946-77; Parliamentary Secretary, U.P., 1946-51 and Opposition Leader, U.P. Legislative Assembly, 1971-77; Founder of Bharatiya Kranti Dal, 1967, Bharatiya Lok Dal, 1974, Janata Party, 1977, and Lok Dal, 1979; Minister, U.P. Government, 1951-67; Chief Minister, U.P., 1967, 1968 and 1970; Home Minister, Government of India, 1977-78; Deputy Prime Minister and Finance Minister, Government of India, 1979, and Prime Minister of India, 1979-80; author of *Abolition of Zamindari*, *Cooperative Farming X-rayed*, *Economic Nightmare of India*.
