



NOT TO BE GIVEN TO ANYONE.

Uttar Pradesh is in a bad shape. One of the main reasons consists in the failure of its political leadership to meet the challenge that the problems of the State have posed. During the past few weeks, a situation has arisen which could bedevil the progress of the State further. Congress and BKD, therefore, have come together and reached an agreement. The terms are being released hereby, for public information.

As for the policies and programmes of the State Government : It will give priority No.1 to providing a clean and efficient administration to the people — an administration under which there will be no waste, no delay and no corruption. Its approach will be mass-oriented, progressive and such as will tend to increase economic production. The interests of big traders or businessmen and big industrialists or financiers shall be given a second place. All measures shall be taken to increase agricultural production, in particular. More stress shall be laid on primary and technical education. Attempts will be made to reform and re-organise education that our human factor is improved, that is, the character of our people is raised, they begin to work hard and become more patriotic. Such steps as may lie in the power of State Govt. and will reduce unemployment and disparities in incomes, shall be unhesitatingly taken. Also, all possible measures that will contribute to uplift of the suppressed and the under-privileged sections of our society, will be implemented with speed.
